Agnes Caroline Hayes was born on December 6, 1920 in Platte Township, MN to the late Walter and Martha (Koselka) Hayes. She grew up on the family farm and attended country school in Platte Township. Agnes was united in marriage to John T. Young on June 28, 1939 at Holy Cross Catholic Church in Harding, MN. Together they farmed near Harding before eventually moving onto a farm in Belle Prairie Township, MN. Agnes worked for several years at Munsingwear as a seamstress in addition to working on the farm and raising her family. She was a master gardener and canned much of what she produced.
