Alfred J. Green, Jr., age 86 of Brainerd, MN, passed away Sunday, January 11, 2009 at Bethany Good Samaritan Village in Brainerd, MN. A Memorial Mass for Alfred Green will be at 1 PM, Friday, January 16, 2009 at Bethany Good Samaritan's Chapel in Brainerd, MN with Father Mark Innocenti officiating. He entered into the Army in 1942 and served in Newfoundland as a radio operator during WWII until being honourably discharged in 1945. Alfred was united in marriage to Jean Boorum on May 22, 1948 in Providence, Rhode Island. Together, they made their home in Providence and also spent some time on Long Island, NY. They moved to Brainerd, MN in 1974, and Alfred started working at the JC Penney store. He retired from JC Penney in 1986. Alfred was a member of Brainerd American Legion Post #255 as well as a charter member of the Cross Lake Knights of Columbus.
