



## Alphonse "Al" Weber

July 12, 1933 - December 19, 2022

Alphonse "Al" Weber, 89 year old resident of Little Falls, MN passed away Monday, December 19, 2022 at his home in Little Falls, MN. A Mass of Christian Burial will take place at 11:00 A.M. on Friday, December 30, 2022 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Little Falls, MN with Father Virgil Helmin officiating. Burial will take place in the St. Mary's Parish Cemetery in Little Falls, MN. A visitation will be held from 4-8 P.M. on Thursday and from 9-10:30 A.M. on Friday at the Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls, MN. Knight of Columbus Office of the Dead will be prayed at 7:00 P.M. on Thursday evening at the Shelley Funeral Chapel. Caring for Al and his family is the Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls, MN.

Al was born on July 12, 1933 in Millwood Township, Stearns County to the late Peter and Veronica (Kerfeld) Weber. He volunteered and served in the United States Army from 1953-55 where he then received an honorable discharge. Shortly after, Al was united in marriage to his wife, Rosemary Roden on June 24, 1958 in Little Falls, MN. He worked various jobs, some included working as a farm hand in the area, then went on to work for Larson Boat Works in Little Falls, Canada, and Ohio. After returning to Little Falls, he managed the Gulf Gas Station until he began his 26 year career at Napa Auto Parts where he retired. After retirement, he worked part-time at the Sears store for 5 years and then went on to work for Rudolph Auto Solutions for several years.

Al was a devoted member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Little Falls where he served as an usher. He was also an active member of the Knights of Columbus where he served as secretary and received multiple awards for the many new members he recruited. Al will forever be remembered as a very kind and faithful man. He was dearly loved and will be greatly missed.

Al is survived by brother, Elmer (Louise) Weber of Alliance, OH; and 15 nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by parents, Peter and Veronica Weber; wife, Rosemary Weber; mother and father-in-law, Matt and Leona Roden; siblings, Monica VanHeel, Evelyn Haselkamp, Irene Goodstein, and Lawrence Weber; niece, Eileen Vanselow; and nephews through marriage, Dan Slimmer, Jerry Bell and Stan Dorris.

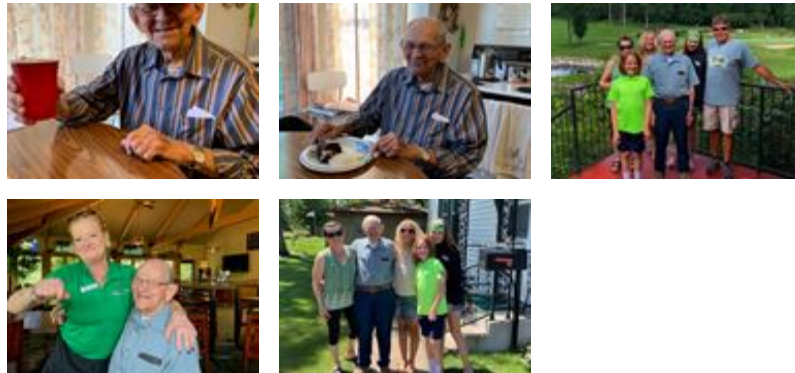

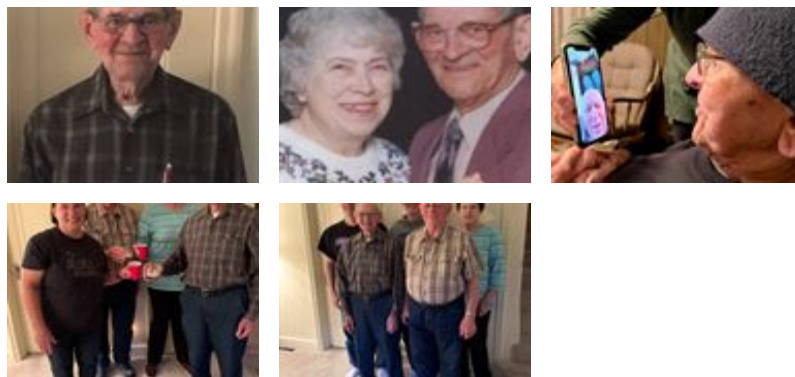
