June 6, 1927 - November 14, 2018

Ann M. Poser, 91 year old resident of Pierz, MN, passed away on Wednesday, November 14, 2018 at the Pierz Villa. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11 AM on Wednesday, November 21, 2018 at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Buckman, MN, with Father Kenneth Popp officiating. Burial will be at Ft. Snelling National Cemetery in Minneapolis, MN. Visitation will be from 9:30 AM to 11 AM Wednesday at the church.

Ann was born to Frank and Barbara Kapsner and raised with 6 brothers and 5 sisters on the family farm outside of Buckman, Mn. It was a busy household where faith and family were most important. She had health challenges during her childhood, which made school attendance difficult. When it was time to enroll for 9th grade, she begged her father to allow her to attend. She must have been persuasive, because she received his permission. This opportunity allowed her to take the prized Home Economics course which changed her life forever. She developed a passion for sewing which continued for the rest of her life.

There was a boy from Pierz, Mn who caught her eye. She and Victor Poser were married in September, 1950. Ann often spoke about the fire that burned down her family's farm house shortly after the wedding, because all of their wedding gifts and her dress were in it. Luckily, no one was injured. Vic and Ann settled and raised their 5 boys in St. Paul, Mn. She was a farm girl who

found her way in the big city.

Ann was industrious and learned and developed skills to wrangle the 5 boys, cooking, cleaning, canning, sewing, school and church activities, and all without driving. She never had a driver's license. The family enjoyed weekend trips back to Buckman to be with family. They all fished, the boys water skied and learned to hunt with their dad and relatives and friends. Life was full and busy for Ann.

The family moved to the suburb of Arden Hills, Mn in the early 70's. The boys graduated and took leave to make their way in the world. Ann and Vic enjoyed their new home, meeting new neighbors who became good friends and enjoying their new church family at St. John the Baptist Church. Ann was a "walker" before it became a "thing". She walked in the neighborhood and made friends along the way- she was amazing. These years brought weddings and the joy of grandchildren. Tragedy struck in 1982, when son Lyle was killed in a trucking accident on the road in Kentucky. Ann's faith was her rock and brought her through this difficult time. Then Vic developed health problems and passed on in June 1990.

Because Ann's friends, neighbors, and family reached out to help her in any way necessary, she was able to live independently in Arden Hills for the next 23 years. She usually had a sewing or quilting needle in her hand, was watching and feeding her birds, listening to music, or reading. She saw her grandchildren grow up and welcomed 4 great-grandchildren into the family.

In 2013 Ann came full circle by moving back "up north" into the Pierz Villa community. We missed having her live close by, but boy did she thrive in her new home. She loved putting together jigsaw puzzles, and participated in all activities, especially BINGO. She got reacquainted with old friends, made new friends, and spent time with her sisters and family. Her Villa family was so

special and gave her the best care and comfort possible.

Ann enjoyed her life up to the end, but when it was time, she was ready to go. We cry because we miss her, but we rejoice that she is pain-free and back in the arms of her Savior.

Ann is survived by her boys, Glenn (Lois) Poser, Dan Poser, Gordon Poser, Dale (Kit) Poser; grandchildren, Carrie (Corin) Poser, Katie Poser, Rus (Alexandra) Poser, Leisa Poser, Heidi Poser; great-grandchildren, Bobby, Christian, Aden, and Ava; sisters, Regina Grittner and Rosetta Weber.

Ann was greeted in heaven by her husband Vic; son, Lyle; infant granddaughter, Stephanie; parents, sisters and brothers. She will be buried by Vic at the Ft. Snelling National Cemetery.

The family would like to thank everyone at the Pierz Villa and Britney and Lisa and staff from Horizon Health and Hospice for their loving care, comfort, and support of Ann. She will be missed.
