



## Arlene M Boser

October 19, 1943 - November 8, 2014

Arlene M. Boser, 71 year old resident of Pierz, MN passed away Saturday, November 8, 2014 at the St. Joseph's Medical Center in Brainerd, MN. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 A.M. on Tuesday, November 11, 2014 at St. John's Catholic Church in Lastrup, MN with Father David Maciej officiating. Burial will take place at St. John's Parish Cemetery in Lastrup. Visitation will from 4 to 8 P.M. on Monday and from 9:00 AM to 10:00 AM on Tuesday at the Shelley-Virnig Funeral Chapel in Pierz, MN. Parish Prayers will be held at 6:00 PM on Monday at the funeral chapel.

Arlene Boser was born on October 19, 1943, in Little Falls, MN, to Rita (Dehler) and Walter Stumpf. She grew up and attended school in the Lastrup area. Arlene graduated from Pierz Memorial High School in 1961 at the age of 17. After graduation, Arlene moved to Minneapolis and worked in the office at Northwestern Bell for five years. She was united in marriage to James Boser on May 31, 1966. Together they farmed in the Lastrup area, and raised three children: Christina, Craig, and Cory. During this time, Arlene also worked for 23 years for the Gary Banick Insurance Agency (later changed to The Insurance Shoppe). Arlene enjoyed her work, as she loved to visit with people and had a great attention to detail. After selling the farm in 2002, Arlene and Jim moved to Pierz. Throughout her life, she enjoyed bowling, being a homemaker, cooking, baking, and gardening. She loved to can and freeze vegetables from her garden, and share her prized homemade pickles with all of her family. Arlene was a lifelong member of St. John Nepomuk Church in

Lastrup, MN.
