Armella M. Prokott, 82 year old resident of the Pierz Villa in Pierz, MN passed away Tuesday, November 27, 2007 at the Pierz Villa. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 AM on Friday, November 30, 2007 at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Buckman, MN with Father Gerald Dalseth officiating. Burial will be in St. Michael's Parish Cemetery in Buckman. She was united in marriage to John Prokott on November 6, 1944. They lived west of Buckman, MN for a few years. The couple then purchased Armella's parent's farm and moved east of Buckman. They farmed until 1970, then built a home near Little Falls. Armella worked at St. Gabriel's Hospital as a cook in the dietary department from 1972, retiring in 1988. In 2001, Armella and John moved into the Harmony House of Pierz where they lived happily for over 3 years. In April 2007, she moved to the Pierz Villa in Pierz.
