Arnie Lucken 92 year old resident of Royalton, MN passed away Tuesday, October 29, 2013 at the Lutheran Care Center in Little Falls, MN. A Mass of Christian Burial will be at 10:30 AM on Monday, November 4, 2013 at Holy Trinity Catholic Church in Royalton, with Father Lurn Virnig officiating. Burial will be at Holy Cross Cemetery in North Prairie, MN. Friends and relatives may call from 2 until 7 PM on Sunday, November 3rd, and from 9:30 to 10:30 AM Monday, both visitations at the church. Christian Mothers will pray the Rosary at 4 PM, and a Parish Prayer Service at 6:30 PM on Sunday. Arnie was born on September 28, 1921 in Fosston, Minnesota to the late Andrew and Olga (Petersen) Lucken. He grew up and graduated from high school in Fosston, MN. After graduating, he attended telegraph school in Minneapolis, MN, and was employed for the railroad in a telegraph office in St. Paul. In 1942, Arnie then joined the US Navy and was stationed on the USS Kephart during WW II as a radioman. He was honorably discharged in 1945 and returned to Minnesota where he worked as a Depot Agent for Northern Pacific. In 1950, he went to California and worked for Southern Pacific Railroad as a conductor until retiring in 1991. Arnie was united in marriage to Evelyn Hurdt on October 2, 1954 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in El Centro, California. In 1995, they moved to Royalton, MN. He loved to travel; visiting all 50 states and Canada. He traveled in his own plane, and drove a Triumph motorcycle, VW bug and his motor home. Arnie loved reading, and was a history buff. He loved animals, especially cats. He will be remembered as

being a very caring person.

Arnie was a member of Holy Trinity Catholic Church, was a 4th Degree Knight and was a member of the Royalton American Legion.

Arnie is survived by his loving wife of 59 years, Evelyn; niece, Teri Mitchell of Michigan; step-niece, LuAnn Severson of Arlington, MN; and many other nieces and nephews. He is preceded in death by his parents; sister Lila Laney; brothers-in-law Reynold and Herbert Hurdt; and sister-in-law Verena Mroska.
