



Arthur "Art" J. Prescott Jr.

Art J. Prescott, 75 year old resident of Little Falls, MN passed away Saturday, December 19, 2015 at the VA Hospital in St. Cloud, MN. Funeral Services will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Wednesday, December 23, 2015 at the Motley Free Methodist Church in Motley, MN with Rev. Jim Johnson officiating. Burial will be at the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery north of Little Falls. Visitation will be from 5 to 8 PM on Tuesday at the Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls and one prior to the service on Wednesday at the church. Military Honors will be provided by the Minnesota State Honor Guard and the Disabled American Veterans.

Art was born October 28, 1940 in Princeton, MN to Arthur and Hoyle Prescott. He attended school in Sandstone, MN graduating in 1959. He enlisted in the U.S. Army Security Agency and served in Germany, Korea, Vietnam, and several other bases in the United States for 15 years. Following his military service, Art held a wide variety of jobs from being an OTR trucker to starting an import business. Art's love of traveling led him around the world, from China, to visit with friends and for business, to Mexico, to follow his passion of doing mission work through the Work and Witness program with the Church of the Nazarene. He loved traveling, fishing (especially in Canada), spending time with his family, and taking his three granddaughters on road trips. With an outgoing personality, Art was able to make friends whether he was standing in line at the grocery store or exploring another country.

Arthur Prescott is survived by his wife, Marilyn of Little Falls, MN; daughter,

Pam (Mike) Huck of Little Falls, MN; three granddaughters, Alyssa, Rachael, and Kristen; brother and sisters, David, Diane, Carol, and Judy; many nieces and nephews. His parents, Arthur and Hoyle Prescott; a son, Arthur John Prescott III preceded him in death. 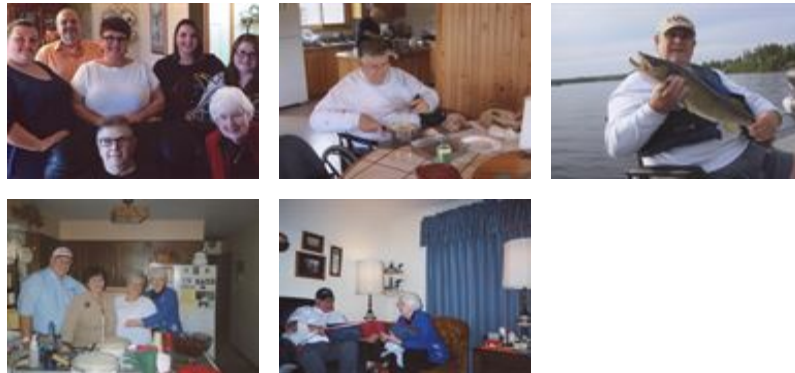
