



Arthur I. Mosier

July 23, 1918 - December 29, 2011

Arthur Mosier was born July 23, 1918 in Parker Township, Morrison County, MN to the late Harry and Alta (Post) Mosier. He grew up in Parker Township and attended country school through the eighth grade. Arthur then went to Little Falls High School, graduating in 1936. He enlisted in the US Army in February, 1939 and served in the Far East during WW II. Following the end of WW II, he returned stateside and remained in the Army. Arthur was united in marriage to Jean Rose Mary Cina on September 17, 1949 at Fort Belvoir, VA. He retired from the US Army on May 31, 1959. The couple moved to Little Falls, MN in 1961. Arthur was employed by the State of Minnesota, working at Camp Ripley until retiring in 1981. Arthur was very active in the Knights of Columbus, becoming a 4th Degree Knight and serving as State Master from 1974-78. He was a life member of the Little Falls VFW Post #1112 and the Little Falls American Legion Post # 46 where he served as Post Commander; Chaplain; Adjutant and District Chaplain. Under his leadership, the Legion began the Post Everlasting Service, recognizing Legionnaires who had died. Arthur was very active in the Hole in the Day Players, a community theatre company. He was also a member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Belle Prairie, MN

Arthur I. Mosier is survived by his wife of 62 years, Jean; son, Gary Mosier of Arlington, TX; daughters, Judithe 'Dr. Barry' Thompson of Gallipolis, OH and Theresa 'David' Larson of Katy, TX; brother, Harry 'Joe' Mosier of Royalton, MN; sister, Ilo Simonsen of Mercer Island, WA; eight grandchildren and two

great grandchildren.

Arthur was preceded in death by his parents, Harry and Alta Mosier; daughter, Mary Hutchings; brother, Melvin Mosier and a sister, Flossia Armstrong.
