Barbara J. Radloff, 66 year old resident of Little Falls, MN, passed away on Monday, August 3, 2015 at St. Otto's Care Center in Little Falls. A Memorial Service will be held at 11 AM on Friday, August 7, 2015 at Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls, with Rev. Hank French officiating. A visitation will be held from 4 PM to 7 PM on Thursday and from 10 AM to 11 AM Friday at the funeral chapel.

Barbara Jean Horky was born on May 17, 1949 in Hutchinson, MN to the late Clarence and Leona (Klatt) Horky. She was baptized and confirmed at 1st Lutheran Church in Hector, MN. Barbara graduated from Hector High School in 1967. She then attended Mankato State College, graduating in 1971 with a Home Economics degree. Barbara was united in marriage to Steven Radloff on September 12, 1970 at 1st Lutheran Church in Hector, MN, where they made their home. In 1974, Barbara and Steven moved to Little Falls, where together they farmed their land. Barbara took care of her 5 acre asparagus patch for over 20 years. Many of the same group of people would come to "pick their own" when the crop was ready. She enjoyed doing crafts, reading, sewing, and spending time at their cabin near Itasca State Park. Every year, Barbara looked forward to getting together with her high school girlfriends known as the "Crazy Eight." She also loved spending time with her grandchildren.

Barbara is survived by her husband, Steve; daughter, Kari (Jared) Hintzman of Menomonie, WI; son, Scott (Angie Helgeson) of Little Falls, MN; grandchildren, Megan and Rachel Hintzman, and Trenton Radloff.

She was preceded in death by her parents; brother, Roger Horky; sister, Bernice Hanson; and stepfather, Lyle Brown.

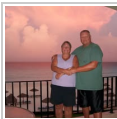
