Benedict E. Psick, 86 year old resident of Little Falls, MN passed away Sunday, July 31, 2011 at St. Gabriel's Hospital in Little Falls. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 A.M. on Wednesday, August 3, 2011 at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church in Little Falls with Father Mark Innocenti officiating. Burial will be at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish Cemetery in Little Falls.
