Bernard was born August 31, 1925 in Wakonda, SD to the late Bert & Gudrun Westre. He grew up near Wakonda, SD and attended country school. Bernard entered the US Army on March 14, 1945 and served until his honorable discharge on June 22, 1946. He was united in marriage to Deloris M. Lancrain on July 27, 1945 at South Sioux, Nebraska. The couple farmed in South Dakota with Bernard's father until 1956. The couple moved to Minnesota and purchased a farm in Little Falls Township. While farming, Bernard also worked at Camp Ripley, Larson Boats and helped with the construction of the Little Falls dam. He later owned and operated the Sanitary Landfill near Little Falls until retiring in 1986 to Alamogordo, NM.

In 2000, the couple returned to the Little Falls area. Bernard enjoyed fishing, growing flowers, (especially roses) and traveling. His great joy was spending time with the grandchildren and great grandchildren. Bernard was a former member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Royalton, MN, a member of the Little Falls VFW and Royalton American Legion.
