Bernett LeBlanc, 92 year old resident of Little Falls, MN passed away Thursday, October 30, 2014 at Diamond Willow Assisted Living in Little Falls, MN. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday, November 4, 2014 at Holy Family Catholic Church in Belle Prairie with Father Joe Herzing officiating. Burial will take place in the Holy Family Parish Cemetery.
