Bernice Meyer, 96 year old resident of Cushing, MN, passed away on Saturday, March 30, 2024 at the St. Cloud Hospital. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11 AM on Thursday, April 4, 2024 at St. James Catholic Church in Randall, MN with visitation one hour prior to mass at the church. Burial will be in the St. James' parish cemetery in Randall. Caring for Bernice and her family is the Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls, MN.

Bernice Magdalene Gross was born on September 14, 1927 on a farm near Lastrup, MN to the late John and Eleanor (Weiss) Gross. She attended country school near Lastrup. Bernice worked at the Brainerd Hospital and also at St. Joseph's Hospital in St. Paul, MN. She was united in marriage to Ephraem E. Meyer on September 9, 1947 at St. John Nepomuk Catholic Church in Lastrup. They moved to a farm west of Randall, MN, in Todd County. They lived there all their lives. Ephraem died on January 19, 2007 and Bernice continued to live on the farm. Bernice was active in her church, St. James, and was a member of their Christian Mothers prayer group as well as being a member of the St. Theresa Mission Circle for many years. She enjoyed making quilts and always had a large garden, and grew beautiful flowers.
