Betty J. Dudycha, 86 year old resident of Cushing, MN passed away peacefully and surrounded by her loving family on Saturday, July 27, 2019 at Amazing Love Elderly Care Center in Randall, MN. A funeral service will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Friday, August 2, 2019 at Randall Presbyterian Church in Randall, MN. Betty enjoyed cooking, canning, crocheting, sewing, embroidering, and bird-watching. She will be remembered as a truly wonderful mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother who loved spending time with her family. She was especially fond of cats and always had one as a pet. Betty was also an active member at Randall Presbyterian Church.

Betty survived a brain aneurysm on July 4, 2010. It was a long road to recovery, but she beat the odds and went on to live several more happy years. Betty was preceded in death by her parents, George and Bertha Horak; brothers, George Jr., Joseph (Pep), Vladimir (Laddie), and Charles; sisters, Frances Johnson, Helen Swanson, and Ruth Heisel.
