June 29, 1925 - December 10, 2014

Betty J. Zobroski, 89 year old resident of Little Falls, MN passed away, Wednesday, December 10, 2014 at St. Gabriel's Hospital in Little Falls, MN. There will be a private burial.

Betty (Molde) Zobroski was born in Little Falls, Minnesota on June 29, 1925 to the late Alfred and Nellie (Hawkins) Molde. Her siblings were Mildred (Molde) Pikus, Richard "Bud" Molde, Violet (Molde) Super, and Shirley Molde. Betty graduated from Little Falls High School in 1943 and after graduation she moved to Pontiac, MI where she worked at Neisner's Variety Store for three years. She returned to Minnesota and worked at Montgomery Wards department store for two years. She then worked as clerk in the finance department at Camp Ripley and later began working for Falls Dental as a receptionist. She also worked for the Morrison County Agricultural office as a clerical staff person. She then decided to go to school and attended the Minnesota School of Business in Minneapolis. Betty began working at Hiawatha Grain, located in Minneapolis' Grain Exchange for several years. She married Arlynn Zobroski on August 31, 1957 and they resided in St. Cloud for several years. It was during that time she began working for the St. Cloud Police Department, where she worked for twenty years. They then moved to Little Falls where they lived together until Arlynn's death in 2003. Betty later began working for Morrison County's Department of Motor Vehicles and worked there for twenty years, retiring in 1999.

She was a member of the Eastern Star, the Sons of Norway, VFW and Legion Auxillaries. Both Betty and Arlynn were founding members of the Stardust Dance Club in Little Falls. It was a members-only club that held dances at times monthly featuring live bands. Betty and Arlynn were both excellent ballroom dancers and especially enjoyed dancing the jitter bug and the waltz.

Betty is survived by daughters, Bonnie (Aaron) Martin of Maplewood, MN; and Cindy (Jayme) Opatz of Holdingford, MN; 4 grandchildren; and sister, Shirley Molde of Little Falls, MN.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Alfred and Nellie; husband, Arlynn; siblings, Mildred, Violet, and Richard "Bud".
