Betty E. Niemann, 88 year old resident of Coon Rapids, MN, formerly of Little Falls, MN passed away Thursday, February 7, 2013 at the St. Anthony Nursing Home in Minneapolis, MN. A Memorial Service will be held at 1:30 P.M. on Wednesday, February 13, 2013 at Zion Lutheran Church in Little Falls, MN with Rev. Gary Hendrickson officiating. Burial will be at the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery north of Little Falls at a later date. Visitation will be one hour prior to the service on Wednesday at the church. Betty E.
