Betty Jane Paulson was born on March 10, 1932 in Hanska, MN, to the late Joseph and Alvina Paulson. She graduated from Hanska High School and from the University of Minnesota School of Agriculture. Betty Jane worked as a secretary at the U of M offices in St. Paul, MN for five years before she married Dean Mason in 1957. The couple lived on a farm near Fort Ripley, MN until 1970, when they moved into Little Falls. Betty Jane then worked in the Little Falls Community School District for 28 years. She was a longtime member of First Lutheran Church where she taught Sunday School classes. Betty Jane was also a member of the Martha Circle, a quilting group, and the Sons of Norway. She was very proud of her Norwegian heritage and enjoyed being part of the Little Falls Community. Betty Jane loved having her family around her, especially during the holidays, and enjoyed many camping trips with her family.
