Charles (Charlie) Michael Schomer, 79, of Lastrup, MN, died Sunday, February 6, 2011, at North Memorial Hospital in Robbinsdale, MN. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 12:30 P.M. on Friday, February 11, 2011, at St. John Nepomuk Church in Lastrup, MN with Father David Maciej officiating. Burial in the parish cemetery will be at a later date. Visitation will be from 4 to 8 p.m. Thursday and from 10:30 a.m. to 12 noon at the Shelley-Virnig Funeral Home in Pierz, MN. Parish prayers will be at 6:30 p.m. Thursday at the funeral home. Funeral arrangements are with the Shelley-Virnig Funeral Chapel in Pierz, MN.

Charles was born April 1, 1931, in Flint, MI, to Michael and Mary (Voelker) Schomer. He grew up in Lastrup, where he attended a two-room school. After graduation from Little Falls High School, he enrolled in a one-year teacher training program. He taught in two rural schools in Morrison County, MN, and saved his money for further education, eventually receiving a B.S. degree in English and math and an M.A. degree in English. Charles taught high school in Deer River, MN, and Aurora, MN; spent a year in England as a foreign exchange teacher; and retired from teaching in 1992.

Charles had many interests and hobbies. He loved to travel, and he liked nothing better than a good conversation on places he had seen or ones he yet wanted to visit. He could also converse on politics, baseball, literature, and many other topics. Most of all he was interested in making life better for others. He looked after and cherished his family and extended that caring

gentleness to people he knew, as well as to those he did not know.

Survivors include his sisters, Mary Ann Schomer, Lastrup, MN; Margaret (Ted) Boatman, St. Cloud, MN; Sister Carleen (Mildred) Schomer, OSB, St. Joseph, MN; and brother, Richard (May) Schomer, Pierz, MN; two nieces and one nephew; one great-niece and two great-nephews; and one great-great-nephew.

He was preceded in death by his parents.
