Claudette Y. Scepaniak, 89 year old resident of Little Falls, MN passed away Friday, October 13, 2023 at St. Otto's Care Center in Little Falls, MN. A Memorial Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 AM on Thursday, October 19, 2023 at St. Otto's Care Center Chapel in Little Falls with Father David Grundman officiating. She lovingly cared for Kristyna and Allison Zak for several years and that developed into a lifelong friendship with the Zak family. Claudy was an only child and dearly loved by her parents. She was a blessing to her parents, helping on the farm and caring for them in their elderly years. Claudy was a devout Christian and a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church. She enjoyed attending mass there and also at the St. Otto's Chapel.

Left to treasure her memory are cousins of the Scepaniak and Maciej families and also her dear friends, along with her caregivers at St. Otto's and the CHI Hospice Program.

Claudette was preceded in death by her parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles and several cousins.
