Cordelia Prokott, 98-year-old resident of Lino Lakes, MN formerly of Bowlus, MN passed away Sunday, June 18, 2017, in Lino Lakes, MN. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Wednesday, June 21, 2017, at St. Stanislaus Catholic Church in Bowlus, MN with Father Greg Mastey officiating. She was a lifelong member of St. Stanislaus Catholic Church in Bowlus, MN where she was a member of the Christian Mother's Rosary Society and assisted with many funeral lunches over the years. Cordelia was always a very faithful attendee of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. She was dearly loved and will be greatly missed.

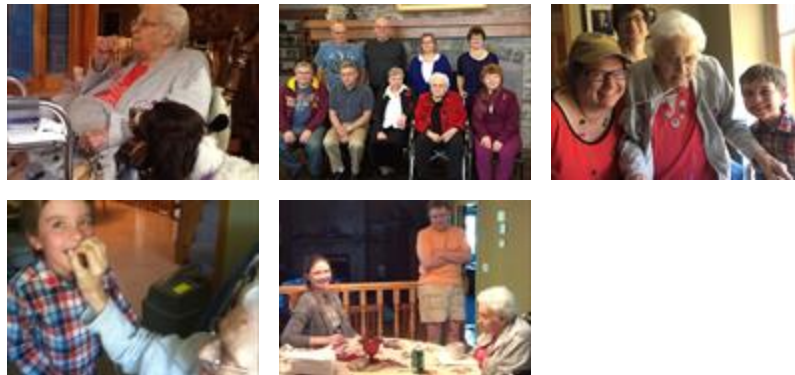
