



Cordella "Cordy" Heroux

April 10, 1938 - September 17, 2017

Cordella "Cordy" Heroux, 79 year old resident of Motley, MN, passed away quietly from cancer on Sunday, September 17, 2017 in Little Falls, MN. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 AM on Saturday, September 23, 2017 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Little Falls, with Father Joe Korf officiating. Burial will be at Calvary Cemetery in Little Falls. A Visitation will be held from 5 to 8 PM on Friday, September 22nd at Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls, and from 9:30 to 10:30 AM Saturday at the church. There will be a Prayer Service at 7 PM on Friday.

Cordy was born on April 10, 1938 in St Augusta, MN. She graduated from St. Cloud Technical High School and St. Gabriel's School of Nursing. She married George Heroux on September 17, 1960 and raised a family of three children, mostly in Foley, MN. She worked as a nurse throughout her life, many years as a county health nurse in rural central Minnesota. After retirement, George and Cordy had 15 years of healthy and active retirement, spending much of their time in southern Texas where Cordy's enjoyment of warm weather could continue even during the winter months. She ended her life with the same joy and kindness she started with, with faith and at peace with what comes. She will be missed by many.

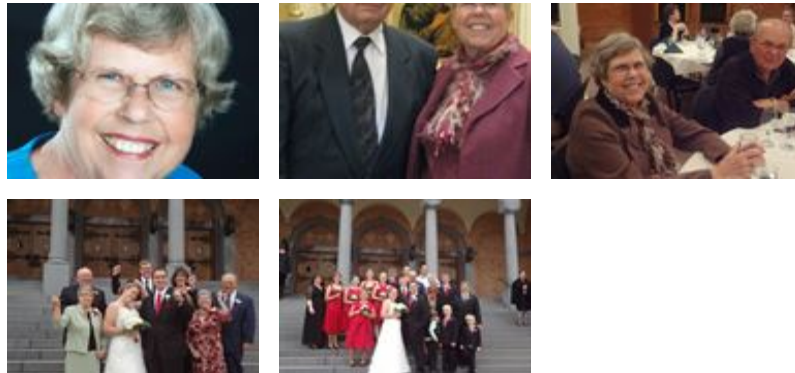

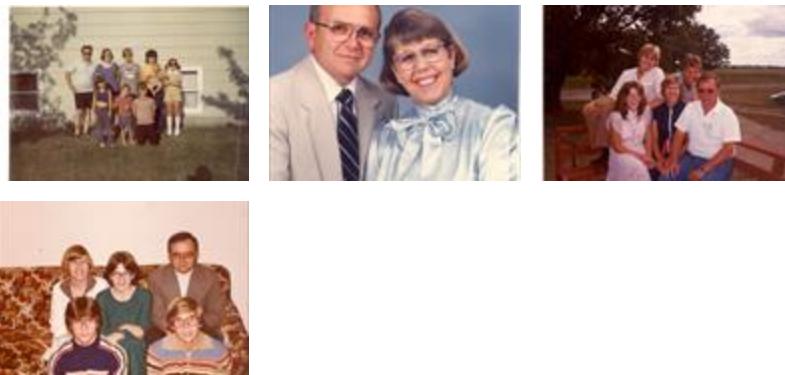
