Dale G. Starr, 88 year old resident of Hillman, MN, passed away Friday, June 5, 2020, at the VA Health Care System in St. Cloud, MN. A funeral service will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday, June 9, 2020 at Bethany Lutheran Church in Ramey, MN with Rev. Wayne Bernau officiating. Burial will take place in the Lone Pine Cemetery in Morrill, MN. A visitation will be held from 10-11 A.M. on Tuesday, June 9, 2020 at Bethany Lutheran Church in Ramey, MN. Military honors will be provided by the Hillman American Legion. Funeral arrangements for Dale are with the Shelley Funeral Chapel.

Dale George Starr was born November 17, 1931, at home in Lakin Township, Morrison County, Minnesota to Minnie (Keehr) and Otto Starr. He grew up on the farm and attended the near-by one room country school and attended two years at the Milaca High School. Dale was a life member of Bethany Lutheran Church, where he was baptized, confirmed, and married. Dale and Rosemarie (Schroeder) were married on August 6, 1956. They farmed in eastern Morrison County the past 63 years. Dale logged and used lumber off his land to build their barn and house.

After retirement, the couple traveled extensively. They wintered in Southern

Texas the past 23 years, where they assisted with many mission trips into Mexico. Dale was a talented wood worker who made many game boards, and carved many animals and fishing lures. He was an outdoor guy who enjoyed elk, deer hunting and fishing.
