Daniel 'Danny' Piekarski Sr., 74 year old resident of Little Falls, MN passed away Saturday, Aug. 29, at his home in Little Falls, MN after a long and courageous battle with cancer. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Friday (Sept. 4) at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Little Falls, MN. Burial will take place at the Minnesota State Veteran's Cemetery north of Little Falls, MN. Daniel entered the Armed Forces at the age of 17 and was proud to be a Paratrooper in the U.S. Army in which he served in the Korean War. He was very proud and honored to serve his country for four years when he was honorably discharged in 1957. Danny volunteered with the D.A.V (Disabled American Veterans) after his retirement and was a lifetime member of the Little Falls VFW Post #1112, American Legion Post #46 and the D.A.V. Dan moved to the Twin Cities area and became employed in the construction field, which he retired in 1992 as a foreman. In iron working, he built many buildings throughout Minnesota. Dan was united in marriage to Florence Heurung on February 15, 1958 and the couple made their home and raised their family in Little Falls, MN.
