She had a deep love for the water—whether pontooning, canoeing, or fishing—and especially treasured time spent with her children and grandchildren. She enjoyed cooking, shopping, family gatherings, and cheering on her beloved Minnesota Vikings. Known for her vibrant sense of humor, she lit up every room she

entered and cherished the hugs she shared with family and friends. Her spirit, laughter, and warmth will be remembered always.
