David Lyle Holtz, 69, passed away peacefully Friday, May 9th at his home in East Bethel, MN.

David was born in Albert Lea and moved at a young age to the Hillman area. He attended Onamia Public School and then enlisted in the U.S. Navy. He earned his GED while in the Navy. David proudly served his country in the U.S. Navy from 1961-1967. During the Vietnam Era David served aboard the USS Sutherland. He was honorably discharged on September 28, 1967 and remained a proud veteran and a member of the Ironton Legion. After his discharge he became a heavy equipment operator and remained in that profession for 33 years. He was a member of the 49's Union. David married Bonnie (Slater) in 1985 and they recently celebrated their 29th wedding anniversary. David enjoyed hunting, fishing, and traveling. He and Bonnie were able to visit all 50 states and Canada during their time together. David's maternal grandfather, Amundson played a significant role in his life as David's father passed away shortly before David was born. He taught David to be honest, to work hard, to be caring and respectful. He taught David to fish, hunt and to respect nature. David had a deep respect and love for his grandfather. David is survived by his wife, Bonnie (Slater) Holtz, two daughters, Stacey Holtz Flake (Jon) and Tracy Holtz-Lopez; one granddaughter, Makayla Lopez; two step daughters, Caprice and DeAnne Miller; three step granddaughters, Paris, Tia, Josie; and one step grandson, Montana; two half-sisters, many nieces, nephews, cousins and his beloved dog, Kelby.
