David L. Tidd, 68 year old resident of Little Falls, MN, passed away on Tuesday, December 21, 2021 at St. Gabriel's Hospital in Little Falls. A Funeral Service will be held at 12 noon on Thursday, January 13, 2022 at the Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls with a visitation 1 hour prior to the service. Burial will be at the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery north of Little Falls. Caring for David and his family is the Shelley Funeral Chapel of Little Falls, MN.

David Lloyd Tidd was born on January 5, 1953 in Minneapolis, MN to Lloyd and Dolores (Doucette) Tidd. In his youth, his nickname was "Davy Crockett". 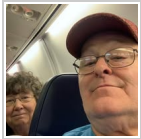

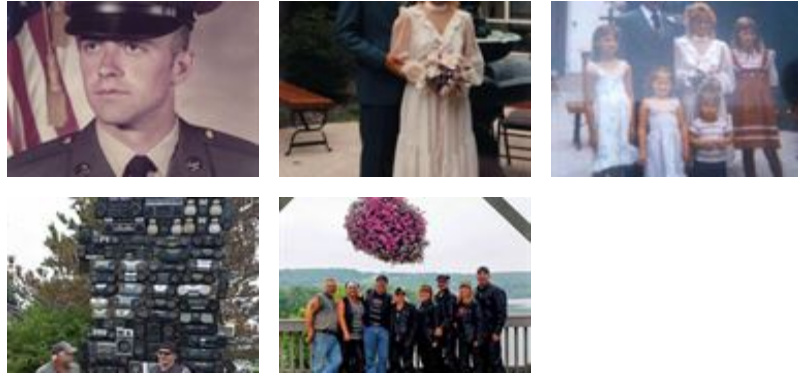
