David M. Lindner, 70 year old resident of Spicer, MN passed away at Hennepin County Medical Center in Minneapolis on Sunday, Sept. 16, 2012, as a result of injuries sustained in a tragic home fire. Committal Services will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Thursday, September 20, 2012 at the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery north of Little Falls with Rev. Damen Heitmann officiating. Burial will also be at the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery. Military Honors will be conducted by the Minnesota State Honor Guard. David M. Lindner was born on January 16, 1942 in Willmar, MN, to the late George Lindner of Willmar, MN & Eleanor (Otterness) Bidwell of New London, MN. David attended school in New London-Spicer, MN. In 1959, at the age of 17, David entered the U.S. Navy. He served for 8 years and was honorably discharged in November of 1968. David was a heavy equipment operator for many years, a skill he acquired while serving as a Seabee in the U.S. Navy, Mobile Construction Battalion Five, during Vietnam. In his younger years he enjoyed snowmobile racing and boat racing. He loved being by the water and was an avid fisherman and hunter. David was also an active member at the New London American Legion.
