



Delrose M. Stoll

May 24, 1925 - March 4, 2018

Delrose (Dellie) M. Stoll, 92-year-old resident of Pierz, MN, passed away at the Edgewood Vista in Brainerd, MN on Sunday, March 4, 2018, surrounded by her family. A Mass of Christian Burial will be at 11:00 A.M., Friday, March 9, 2018 at St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Pierz, MN with Father Kenneth Popp officiating. Burial will be at St. Joseph's Parish Cemetery in Pierz at a later date. Visitation will be Thursday from 4 to 7 P.M. and from 9 to 10:30 A.M. on Friday all at the Shelley Funeral Chapel in Pierz. Parish Prayers will be held at 7 P.M. on Thursday.

Delrose ("Dellie") Stoll was born May 24, 1925 to Frank and Theresa (Flicker) Gruber. She grew up in Genola and graduated from Little Falls High School. Dellie attended the Army Cadet Nurse Program at St. Mary's School of Nursing. The war ended before she graduated with her RN Degree, so she never served in the army, but went to work at St. Joseph's Hospital in St. Paul. Dellie met Bill Stoll while riding the school bus to Little Falls, but never began dating until after graduation. They dated while Bill attended the University of Minnesota and were married on September 6, 1947. They lived and worked in St. Paul for a year before moving to Pierz, where Bill began his banking career at Farmers and Merchants State Bank.

They began raising their family two years later, when daughter Mary Lee was born, followed by Carolyn, Tom, and Robert. Dellie's main focus was, and

always has been, caring for her husband and family. Her deep faith was very important to her, which showed itself in service: cleaning the church, annual bazaars, serving at funerals, and baking bars for any and every occasion! Her service extended to the Pierz community through her volunteer work at the St. Joseph's School library, Pierz Villa gift shop, and her nursing help with screens for blood pressure, vision, hearing, and scoliosis. She was also involved with Christian Mothers and the American Legion Auxiliary. Dellie helped foster close-knit neighborhood friendships and felt blessed to have close ties with her siblings. She readily gave of her time and talents. Dellie and Bill enjoyed traveling extensively through the years, visiting every continent, including Antarctica!

Dellie is survived by daughters, Mary Lee (Daniel) Brixius of Portland, OR, Carolyn (Monte) Morken of Nisswa, MN; sons, Tom (Lisa) Stoll of Milaca, MN and Robert (Loriese) Stoll of Lake Shore, MN; 8 grandchildren, and 11 great-grandchildren; sister, Lila (Norm) Thielen; brothers, Gene (Millie) Gruber and Fred (Marge) Gruber.

Dellie was preceded in death by the love of her life, Bill; sisters Lavina, Lucille and Lone, and by twin granddaughters.
