



## Donald E. Szczodroski

Donald E. Szczodroski, 75 year old resident of Little Falls, MN, passed away Tuesday, March 17, 2026, at St. Otto's Care Center in Little Falls. A funeral service will be held on Tuesday, March 24, 2026, at 11:00 AM, at St. Otto's Care Center in Little Falls, with Deacon Matthew Ludick officiating. Visitation will be from 9:30-11:00 AM, at St. Otto's Care Center prior to the service. Burial will take place in St. Mary's Catholic Cemetery. Donald was born on May 26, 1950, to the late Felix and Leona (Nagel) Szczodroski. He was united in marriage to Sharon Anderson on November 18, 1972, and in 1979, their son Christopher completed their family. Donny's strong work ethic began at an early age. As a young boy of about six years old, he would hitchhike from Little Falls to Camp Ripley to shine shoes, then make his way back home—already showing the determination that he would carry throughout his life. In the late 60's, he worked road construction in Detroit, Michigan, and in the late 70's, at Larson Boats. He went on to build a long and dedicated career as a machinist at National Bushing, now Auto Value, where he worked for over 30 years. Outside of work, Donny enjoyed a wide range of hobbies. Whether he was bowling, throwing darts, playing pool, or riding motorcycle, his best friend – his son, Chris – was alongside him. These moments brought them both great joy, creating cherished memories

and even more great stories. Donny will be remembered for his willingness to help others. He was the person most called when they found themselves in a tough spot, and he never hesitated to lend a helping hand. Donny was someone people knew they could always count on.

He will be deeply missed by his wife, Sharon; his son, Chris (Amanda); his granddaughters, Haley, Ava, Piper, and all who had the privilege of knowing and loving him.

Donny was preceded in death by his parents, Felix and Leona Szczodroski; and brother, John Szczodroski.
