Dorothy A. Allen, 93 year old resident of Little Falls, MN, passed away on Monday, January 4, 2016 at St. Gabriel's Hospital in Little Falls. A Funeral Service will be held at 11 AM on Monday, January 11, 2016 at Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls, with a visitation one hour prior to the service Monday. Interment will be at the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery north of Little Falls.

Dorothy Ann Scheeler was born on July 17, 1922 in Dickinson, ND, to the late Nick and Catherine (Shaff) Scheeler. Dorothy was united in marriage to Lawrence Allen on October 17, 1941 in Wibaux, MT. In 1949, the couple moved to the Little Falls area where they purchased a farm. Together they operated the farm for 48 years, until moving into the city of Little Falls in 1993. In addition to working on the farm, Dorothy worked as a seamstress for Munsingwear for 3 years. When her friend Paul Larson started his boat manufacturing plant in Little Falls, Dorothy became his first "Lead-Woman" in charge of the sewing and upholstery department, and worked there for 26 years, retiring in 1992. Dorothy was an avid flower gardener, and many people stopped to admire her flowers. She was very creative with her sewing and quilt making, as well as painting. Dorothy enjoyed doing puzzles, going fishing, and attending music concerts. She was lucky at cards and playing bingo. Dorothy is best remembered for her great memory, her storytelling and sense of humor.

Dorothy is survived by her son, Dorian Allen of Clarissa, MN; daughter, Marlys

Allen of Little Falls; nephews, Arvid (Arlene) Wiench and Dr. DeLane (Pattee) Wiench; and niece, Dorene Byers.

She was preceded in death by her parents; husband, Lawrence; brothers, Alfred, Raymond, and Leo Scheeler; and sisters, Marilyn Wiench, Othelia "Tillie" Saunders, Delores Castro, and Evelyn Bennett.

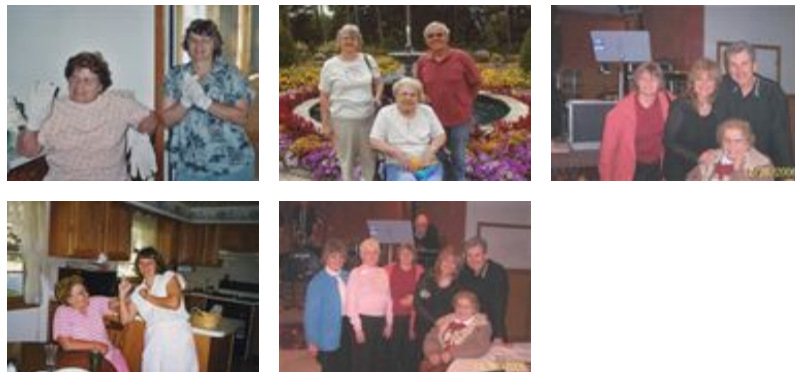
