Dorothy M. Nichols, 99-year-old resident of Little Falls, MN, passed away Tuesday, April 4, 2017 at Diamond Willow in Little Falls, MN. A Memorial Service will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Saturday, June 24, 2017 at Living Hope Assembly of God Church in Little Falls, MN with Rev. Keith Thompson officiating. They were married on May 14, 1943 in Little Falls by the Rev. Arvid Kingswriter at the Assembly of God Church. They moved to Minneapolis for a year or so before moving back to Little Falls where they rented a cabin at the Shady Pine Tourist camp that her in-laws, P.G. & Alta Nichols owned. Both her and James worked for them. Later they moved to Tucson, AZ where Dorothy raised their family. She was a faithful member of the Assembly of God Church, as well as, Sunday school teacher and children's church leader. She enjoyed entertaining family & friends in their home they had built with their own hands. She enjoyed knitting, sewing, crafts, camping, rock hunting, rabbit hunting, bike riding and walking with her family. In 1968 they moved back to Little Falls where she did domestic work, enjoyed working their large garden

and did a lot of canning. She was a faithful member of Living Hope Assembly of God Church, where she taught Sunday school for many years. Dorothy loved to read and study her bible. She was a seasoned prayer warrior, exemplified the love of God and was a confidant for many years. Dorothy was also an example of Christ for her children and many others.
