



## Douglas G. Lindner

Douglas Lindner, 67 year old resident of New London, MN passed away Tuesday, August 5, 2015 at the V.A. Medical Center in St. Cloud, MN. A Celebration of Doug's Life will be held from 4-6 pm on Thursday, August 13, 2015 at New London American Legion Post #537. Burial will be held at the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery north of Little Falls, MN.

Douglas "Dougie" George Lindner was born on October 7, 1947 in Willmar, Minnesota to the late George Lindner and Eleanor (Otterness) Bidwell. He graduated from Atwater High School in 1965, and in October, entered into the United States Navy. Doug served as an Electricians Mate during the Vietnam era and was honorably discharged in 1968. He returned to the Spicer area and continued to work on sea going research vessels, including for Scripps Institute of Oceanography USC and the University of Rhode Island. Doug also sailed and worked on tug boats for Moran Towing out of New York and Miami. In 2001, he went to work for Little Crow Sports Center in Spicer, Minnesota as a Marine Mechanic, working there until May of 2015. Doug enjoyed hunting, fishing, and spending time outdoors. He liked listening to talk radio. Doug was a very helpful, thoughtful and caring person and was always willing to lend a hand.
