



Dr. Michael J. Fa

April 9, 1922 - March 4, 2017

Dr. Michael J. Fa transitioned into new life on March 4, 2017 in his “2nd” hometown, Little Falls, MN. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Saturday, March 11, 2017 at Holy Family Catholic Church in Belle Prairie with Father Joe Herzing officiating. Burial will take place in the Holy Family Parish Cemetery in Belle Prairie. A visitation will be held from 10-11 A.M. on Saturday at Holy Family Parish Church. Funeral arrangements are with the Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls, MN.

He was born on April 9, 1922 in Kikinda of former Yugoslavia. Michael married the love of his life Eva Muller in Szombathely, Hungary and fathered two children, “Little Eva” and “Little Michael”. In 1956, at the onset of the Hungarian Revolution, Michael packed up his family along with a few belongings and fled the oppression of Soviet communism for a better life at an unknown destination.

After a year of living in refugee camps and with immigrant sponsors in Switzerland, Michael and his family were welcomed into the United States where he made a new life for his family, eventually settling in Little Falls, his “2nd” hometown where he served the farming community as a district veterinarian for the State of Minnesota.

Michael is preceded in death by his beloved wife Eva. He is survived by his

daughter, Eva (Fa) Krominga, son, Michael G. Fa; grandchildren, Alyson Krominga, Ashley Krominga Hill and Dr. Jesse Fa; great-grandchildren, Christian Fa (Ian) and Evalynna Fa (Lynna).

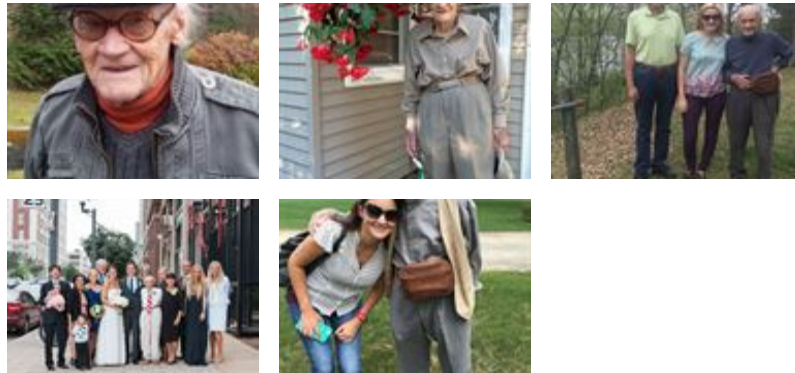
