“ What a big sister! My earliest memories are of Elaine teaching me my prayers and yanking the snarls out of my hair every Saturday night, so I could look pretty for church on Sunday. Guess I was as close as she ever got to having a real baby of her own. Other memories are waking up in the summer to pebbles being thrown on my upstairs window on Saturday morning. It was Elaine wanting me to get up so we could ‘play’. Another memory is Elaine and Mary Lou taking me out to the pasture with them to see if the hazelnuts were ripe. We didn’t know the neighbor’s bull had jumped into our pasture. Out of the brush he roared with Elaine grabbing my hand and telling me to ‘Run’. She got me under the barbed wire fence and into the tall cornfield. We could hear Mary Lou behind us - and the bull too! Elaine was smart enough to keep changing rows to confuse the bull. By this time my little 4 or 5 year old legs had given out. She dragged me across the lawn yelling for mama to open the door. We got inside the porch, but no sign of Mary Lou. Finally she came out close to the barn and was sprinting across the lawn as the bull was coming out of the cornfield. He circled the house several times bellowing to let us know he felt cheated! Elaine and I remained close after I graduated and moved to Minneapolis. I know it broke her heart when I moved to Georgia with my newborn son, but we always had a good time when we would spend our vacation in Minnesota. She loved my little boy, Kim. His favorite name for her was “The Old Duffer”. So many wonderful memories, so many stories! I’ve lost something that cannot be replaced, but I’m thankful for all the memories, laughs, love and support. Elaine was a legend, one of a kind! I know she understands I cannot come to Minnesota for her final rites. She knows how sick my John is, and my place is by his side. Rest In Peace, Old Duffer! We’ll meet again. Signed:
