



Elvin "Charlie" E. LeBlanc

Elvin "Charlie" LeBlanc, 98 year resident of Little Falls, MN passed away Tuesday, April 28, 2020 at St. Gabriel's Hospital in Little Falls, MN. A private family graveside service will be held at Holy Family Catholic Cemetery in Belle Prairie, MN. Funeral arrangements are with the Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls, MN.

Elvin (Charlie) Eugene LeBlanc was born on July 15, 1921 in rural Little Falls to the late Joseph & Adeline (Brousseau) LeBlanc. Charlie attended school in rural Little Falls. He joined the Conservation Camps in 1939 at the age of 17. He spent 1 year there, returned home and joined again at 19. He then went to Chicago and worked. He returned to Little Falls and married Bennett Bartle on May 18, 1943. They lived in rural Little Falls. Charlie was very ambitious. He farmed and did custom com picking. He worked for an implement dealer and different car dealers before purchasing his own dealership, 122 Motors. He sold the car dealership in 1987 and farmed and raised cattle with his son, Gregg. He was very proud of his cattle. Charlie and Bennett went on many hunting and fishing trips with their motor home, Colorado to Canada and many places in between. Charlie was always ready to go fishing and hunting. He loved being a father, grandfather and great-grandfather, and they loved him. Charlie was a lifelong member of Holy Family Parish, and a member of the Knights of Columbus. He was a very proud man with the biggest heart and will be greatly missed.
