



## Emie Hippe

August 14, 1903 - December 12, 2007

Emie Hippe was born on August 14, 1903 in Swanville, Minnesota to the late Alfred & Sophie “Lekberg” Anderson. She grew up in rural Swanville and attended District #126 country school. Upon completing her schooling, Emie worked as a clerk in the Upsala Hardware Store and then as a clerk at Tyvall’s Grocery Store in Swanville. Emie was united in marriage to Benjamin Z. Hippe on December 26, 1926 at the Covenant Church in Upsala. After their marriage, the couple moved to Upsala. In 1933, they built the Lakeside Pavilion on Cedar Lake where people gathered to dance and roller skate. On May 13, 1948 the Pavilion was destroyed by a fire and all of Emie’s children and hired man were killed. Evar Peterson escaped by jumping from the second floor window onto a garage roof. Donald was standing in the window and Evar said “Stay There, I’ll get a ladder.” When Evar returned to the window, Donald had gone back inside to get his brother and sister, but the flames were blazing out the window. Her children were; Donald, age 21, who had just returned from serving 3 years in the U.S. Navy; Delores, age 18, had just graduated from Upsala High School; Delbert, age 16 and hired man, August Nordstrom. They rebuilt on the site, the Cedar Lake Resort which they operated for many years. Emie enjoyed crocheting, fishing, trapping, deer and coon hunting. She was a member of Community Covenant Church in Upsala. Emie will be remembered for her sharp memory, and her warm and humorous personality. Emie is survived by her many nieces and nephews. Emie was preceded in death by her husband, Benjamin Hippe (died suddenly

of a heart attack at the resort on Nov. 11, 1954 - Armistice Day); children, Donald, Delores and Delbert; parents; sisters, Ethel Peterson, Edith Thompson and Elvie Hippe her twin sister; brothers, Edgar & Elmer Anderson.
