Eva was born on December 24, 1918 in Stark County, Scheffield, ND to the late Anton and Isabella (Berger) Schoch. She was united in marriage to John Frank on November 6, 1940 at St. Pius Catholic Church in Scheffield, ND. In 1947 they moved to a 120 acre dairy farm in Sobieski, MN. Eva was a homemaker, raising eight children. She was a member of St. Stanislaus Catholic Church Choir and St. Anne's Mission Group. Eva loved to read and do quilting. She also enjoyed her flower gardens, playing cards, Scrabble, and camping.
