Evelyn was born August 2, 1919 in Minneapolis to the late Emil and Ellen (Bjork) Bloomdahl. The family moved to a farm near Hillman, MN where she attended country school. Evelyn was united in marriage to Henry Hansmann in 1940 in Hillman, MN and they farmed in Leigh Township, about one mile from Hillman. Evelyn was also employed as a seamstress at Munsingwear in Little Falls until the plant closed. She then worked at Crestliner Boats in Little Falls until 1979 when Henry passed away. In 1980 Evelyn began cleaning homes in Minneapolis until her retirement several years later. She resided at the farm in Hillman until becoming a resident of Pierz Villa in 2002. Evelyn enjoyed crocheting, embroidery, quilting and traveling. She especially liked dinner parties at her home. Evelyn's specialty was fried chicken and blueberry pie. She was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Hillman.
