They moved around Little Falls and the Randall area until Florence was a little sneaky and bought the house on the west side, where they remained until today. She had many jobs throughout their marriage and was a hard worker to help support their family. Ma was known

for playing cards, especially cribbage, smear and shit on your neighbor was a favorite for all. She was a great cook and made the best soup around. She could fillet pan fish and did it with a butcher knife. She and D were a hunting, fishing and turtling family and taught these things to all their kids and grandkids.
