George F. Posterick, 82 year old resident of Little Falls, died October 13, 2007 at his home.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held Wednesday, October 17, 2007 at 10:00 A.M. at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church in Little Falls with Father Mark Innocenti officiating. Interment will be in the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery north of Little Falls. Military Rites will be conducted by the Little Falls American Legion Post #46. He loved farming and gardening. His biggest joys in life were his grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
