George C. Vogt was born on February 23, 1920 in Morris, Stevens County, Minnesota to the late Columbus & Sarah (Banister) Vogt. He grew up in the Morris and Sudan area and attended country school there. Upon graduation he attended the University of Morris for agriculture until he was drafted into the U.S. Army in 1941 and was honorably discharged in January 1946. He then attended Dunwoody College and became a master electrician. George was united in marriage to Helen E. Ziesemer on October 17, 1948 at Pepperton Methodist Church in Alberta, MN. The couple made their home in Green Prairie Township, Morrison County in 1952 where they raised five children and also were foster parents to many children for over 30 years. George started his career working for DeRosier Electric, Falls Electric, and then working for IBEW Local #242 receiving a certificate and pin in 2008 for being a union member for 55 years. He served as Secretary/Treasurer for the Little Falls Rifle and Pistol Club for 53 years, Supervisor for Green Prairie Township for 24 years. He was a lifetime member of the VFW, and a member of the American Legion. George was the recipient of a Freedom Flight trip to Washington D.C. for WWII Veterans. He was a faithful member of Zion Lutheran Church where he served as a trustee for many years. George enjoyed farming, hunting, coin collecting, playing cribbage, and spending time with his children and grandchildren.
