Glenn H. Cyrus 81 year old resident of Motley, MN passed away Thursday, November 28, 2013 at the Lakewood Health Systems in Staples, MN. Funeral services will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Monday, December 2, 2013 at the Motley Free Methodist Church in Motley, MN with Rev. Jim Johnson officiating. Glenn was born on June 8, 1932 in Darling Township, Morrison County to the late Harvey and Evelyn (Sullivan) Cyrus. He grew up in the Randall area where he attended grade school and later graduated from Little Falls Community High School with the Class of 1950. Glenn was united in marriage to Audrey Symanietz on November 22, 1952 in South St. Paul, MN. He was drafted into the US Army on June 12, 1953 and served during the Korean War. Glenn was honorably discharged on May 14, 1955. He resided in Randall, MN for many years and later moved to Motley, MN. He owned and operated Cyrus Auto Parts in Motley for many years. Glenn loved cars, he worked on them and sold them up until a few days before he passed away. He especially enjoyed restoring the older cars. Glenn also had a passion for old country music and playing the guitar. He was a member of the Motley Free Methodist Church and the Motley American Legion. Glenn had a soft spot in his heart for animals, especially cats and his great-grandchildren, whom he was known to tease from time to time. He was greatly loved and will be dearly missed.

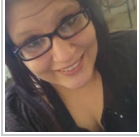

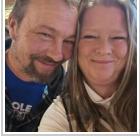
