Harry W. Heinz was born December 22, 1923 in Platte Township, Morrison County, MN to the late Joseph & Mary (Fuhrman) Heinz. He grew up in Platte Township and attended country school in Buh Township. Upon completing his schooling, Harry worked in the winters logging in Northern Minnesota and in the summers, harvesting in Minnesota and North Dakota. He entered the U.S. Army on December 5, 1944 and served in the Philippines, Luzon, and Japan. Harry was a decorated veteran serving with the 158th Infantry and Military Police until his honorable discharge on November 11, 1946. Harry returned to Little Falls and worked at Hennepin Paper Mill for two years. He was united in marriage to Helen E. Rudolph on Sept 22, 1948 at St. James Catholic Church in Randall. The couple began dairy farming in Belle Prairie Township (NE of Freedhem) until 1985. Harry was also the welder and mechanic for local farmers. He enjoyed hunting and fishing in his spare time. Harry was a member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Belle Prairie. Harry W. Heinz is survived by wife Helen; sons, Harold (Shirley) Heinz of Freedhem, MN and Henry (Dorothy) Heinz of Freedhem, MN; daughters, Gladys Lott of St. Cloud, MN, Gloria Spaulding of St. Cloud, MN and Grace Gulden of White Bear Lake, MN; sisters, Dolores Lundsten of Grand Forks, ND and Theresa Friesen of Duarte, CA; 11 grandchildren and one great-grandchild.
