Hazel attended country school, helped on the family farm and worked wherever she could to help her parents. She remembers her parents taking the family to barn dances and house parties while growing up. While working in Kenyon, MN, Hazel met Arnold Hoffdahl. They were united in marriage on April 13, 1929 and moved to Randall, MN in 1930. Hazel took care of the growing family while Arnold was the Randall Creamery manager for 42 years. The couple enjoyed going to the Senior Dances in Brainerd, league bowling and fishing. Hazel's words of wisdom were, "I think learning to live without having everything you want would be important." Hazel's faith in the Lord was always an important part of her life. She was a member of the Randall Presbyterian Church, served as Treasurer of the Women's Group, Treasurer of the Civic League Club and Treasurer of the Randall Senior Citizens Club.
