Helen J. Haggard, 101 year old resident of Little Falls, MN, passed away on Monday, June 2, 2014 at Highland Senior Living in Little Falls. A Memorial Service for Helen will be held at 2:30 PM on Wednesday, July 30, 2014 at Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls. Pastor Jean Megorden and Rev. Kay Johnson will officiate and burial will be at Oakland Cemetery in Little Falls. Visitation will be from 2 until 2:30 PM on Wednesday at our chapel.

Helen Judith Johnson was born on August 18, 1912 in Little Falls to the late Nils and Betty (Olsson) Johnson. She grew up in Little Falls where she attended local schools, graduating from Little Falls High School in 1930. Following graduation, Helen worked for Methner's Variety Store for nine years during the Depression. During World War II she was employed as chief clerk by the OPA (Office of Price Administration) from 1942-1946. In 1946 Helen began her tenure at the Morrison County Auditors Office as a clerk and in 1961 was appointed deputy auditor. On February 23, 1946, Helen married George D. Haggard at the Little Brown Church in the Vale. George died in 1973. Helen continued working until her retirement in 1976. She was a life member and the oldest known living member of Bethel Lutheran Church where she served in many church organizations throughout her lifetime. She was a life member of both the American Legion Auxiliary and the American Swedish Institute.

Helen is survived by many nieces and nephews, great nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her parents, husband George, brothers Edward, Alex, Aner, Louis "Pata" Johnson, an infant brother Elmer, and sisters Alma Larson, Olga Johnson and Nell Anderson.
