Henry S. Wunderlich, 77 year old resident of Burtrum, MN passed away Sunday, January 13, 2008 surrounded by his family at Melrose Community Hospital in Melrose, MN. Funeral services will be held Thursday at 1:00 PM at Faith Community Church in Burtrum with Rev. Bob Munson officiating. Burial will be in Moses Dane Cemetery near Burtrum, MN. Henry S. Wunderlich was born February 24, 1930 in Brainerd, MN to the late Earl and Vera (Coffeen) Wunderlich. He was united in marriage to Elizabeth (Osman) on November 6, 1948 at Swanville Congregational Church. The couple moved from Brainerd to rural Burtrum in 1956 where Henry was a painter and farmed. He was employed by St. Gabriel's Hospital for thirteen years. After retiring, he become an avid fisherman and gardener, annually competing with his brother Bill for the largest watermelon. Henry was a deacon and treasurer at the Burtrum Faith Community Church (formerly Evangelical Free Church). Upon his father's death, Henry continued the family tradition with his involvement in the annual Burtrum Bean Bake.
