Herbert M. "Hub" Virnig, 65 year old resident of Pierz, MN, passed away Sunday, September 20, 2009 at St. Cloud Hospital. A Mass of Christian Burial for Herbert will be held at 10:30 AM Thursday, September 24 at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Pierz, with Father Gerald Dalseth officiating. Burial will be at St. John Nepomuk Parish Cemetery in Lastrup, MN. Visitation will be from 4 to 8 PM Wednesday, September 23, and also from 9-10 AM on Thursday at the Shelley-Virnig Funeral Chapel in Pierz. Christian Mothers will pray the rosary at 4:30 PM followed by Parish Prayers at 6:30 PM and Knights of Columbus Office of the Dead prayer service at 7 PM Wednesday.
