July 5, 1934 - September 24, 2012

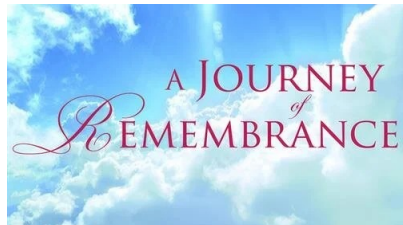

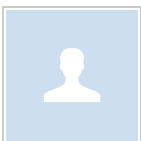
