Howard E. Blomberg Jr., 65 year old resident of Little Falls, MN passed away Tuesday, February 4, 2014 at his home. A Memorial Service will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Saturday, February 15, 2014 at the Shelley Funeral Chapel in Little Falls with Chaplain Gregg Valentine officiating. Burial will be at Oakland Cemetery in Little Falls, MN at a later date. Visitation will be one hour prior to the service on Saturday at the Shelley Funeral Chapel.

Howard Edward Blomberg Jr. was born on August 28, 1948 in Amery, Wisconsin to Howard and Bernice (Tourville) Blomberg. He died suddenly on February 4, 2014. Howard spent his early childhood on the family farm near Emerald, Wisconsin. At the age of 13 he moved with his family to a farm north of Little Falls, MN. Howard graduated from Little Falls High School in 1966. Howard attended trade school and became a machinist. He later became a licensed master plumber. Howard held various jobs in this capacity around the Little Falls area including Camp Ripley.
